In my art piece I used many different elements of art. One of the elements I included is the use of lines. In many of my pictures the horizon is visible and creates a line that separates the ground and trees from the sky. These animals are made with one big rectangle that creates the torso, four skinny rectangles that create the legs, and one rectangle that creates the head. There are also many principles of art used in my piece. One of these principles is repetition. A repetition in one of my pictures is the hay bales. The bales are arranged together in rows that are repeated over and over again, creating a large field of hay bales. Another principle used is balance. Balance is incorporated with every image. The balance is in the color scheme. Every image has green, blue and brown. This creates equilibrium of color throughout the entire art piece.
